Dear Kodály Teacher Training Participant,

Thank you for registering to participate in the 2009 Kodály Institute of Houston. We are delighted to have you with us for 12 intense days of study and enrichment. Below, please find all the pertinent information you will need before the start of the class.

Directions to the Moores School of Music

To reach the University of Houston from I-45 southbound, take the Cullen Blvd. exit just south of downtown and turn right on Cullen Blvd. From I-45 northbound, take the Elgin/Cullen/Lockwood exit just before downtown and turn left on Elgin, then left on Cullen. Use UH Entrance 16 off Cullen Blvd. to reach the Moores School of Music building. Campus maps are available at www.uh.edu.

Parking

Yellow parking permits will be sent to you via mail. This permit **MUST** be displayed on the dashboard of your car whenever you are parked at the University. It will only allow you to park in Lot 16B, which is the large student parking lot directly in front of the Moores School of Music. Please do not park in the faculty or staff lots or you will be ticketed.

Rooms

On the first day of the institute, report to room 131 at 8:30am. There will be signs posted to direct you to the room.

Materials

Materials you have purchased will be available at the first class on July 20, starting at 8:30 a.m. Course syllabi can be found on the PCS website at www.pcs.uh.edu under the Professional Workshops/Kodály Institute link.

Daily Schedule

The class will run from 9 a.m.—6 p.m. July 20-24, July 27-28, August 3-7, 2009. A full schedule is included in this letter.
